# Project Financing Request Checklist of Required Documents

## For New Projects

- ✓ Project feasibility study including Bill of Quantities and specifications for building and constructions (2 copies)
- ✓ Investment licence (original and photocopy)
- ✓ Principal regi8stration certificate (original and Photocopy)
- ✓ Trade license from the concerned organ (original and Photocopy)
- ✓ Land ownership certificate from authorized municipality or other Gov. organ (original and Photocopy)
- ✓ Land lease agreement and land lease certificate for leased land (original and Photocopy)
- ✓ Article and memorandum of associations for applicants other than sole proprietorship (original and Photocopy)
- ✓ Most recent (not latter than two months) proforma invoices for all machinery, Equipment, furniture and fittings and raw materials from known and acceptable suppliers.
- ✓ Letter of privilege from Investment Office for duty free status (detailed list)
- ✓ Power of attorney if the loan is to be negotiated with a person other than authorized in the license of Article of Association

## For Expansion / Rehabilitation Projects

- All the required legal documents of the existing business
- > Feasibility study document in two copies
- Audited financial statements including Cash flow for the last consecutive five years
- ➤ If audited statements are not available, provisional statements including cash flow for the last consecutive five years
- Inventory of all fixed assets priced at their book value and an estimated current disposal market value
- ➤ List of fixed assets to be replaced with their book value and estimated current disposal market value
- ➤ List of fixed assets to be bought and their market price supported by upto-date proforma invoices
- Projected financial statements for the life of the project with and without the expansion/rehabilitation project

#### Contents of the Feasibility Study

The feasibility study should contain

- Project background and basic idea of the project including motivations
- Detailed market analysis (demand and supply analysis) and marketing strategy including associated marketing costs
- Raw material study that includes classification of raw materials, specification requirements, availability and supply, supply programs and cost of raw materials
- Location, site and environmental impacts and cost estimates/expenditure on location development and environment protection
- Engineering and technology including production program, process and plant capacity, technology choice or technical partners and justification for choice; technology acquisition and transfer, detailed plant layout and basic engineering, civil engineering works, maintenance and replacement requirements, details of cost estimates/Expenditures supported by valid proforma invoices
- Organization and overhead costs including organization design, organization structure, management and overhead cost
- Human Resources including categories and functions, CV of key employees, availability and recruitment training plan and detailed cost estimates
- Project implementation plan and budgeting including stages of project implementation, implementation schedule, projection and implementation budget
- Financial analysis and investment appraisal including assumption costbenefit analysis, methods of investment appraisal, projected financial statements for the project life, associated financial and efficiency ratios and other investment viability indicators such as NPV and IRR.

### Required Schedules/Statements annexed to the Feasibility study

- Projected sales programmes
- Estimates of total marketing costs
- Detailed estimates of costs of raw materials and supplies
- Estimates of investment costs by category of investment, i.e., Civil works, machinery and equipment, furniture and fittings, initial working capital etc...
- Detailed estimates of production and overhead costs
- Detailed estimate of personnel cost
- Estimates of pre-production costs
- Estimates of total annual costs of products sold
- Estimates of total working capital requirements
- Sources of finance
- Schedule of debt service (repayment schedule)
- Projected financial statements including cash flows
- Financial analysis and appraisal tables
- Project implementation charts.
